

**Figure III.12. Principal supervisors' perceptions of the quality of their district's principal supervisor evaluation system in PSI and other urban districts**

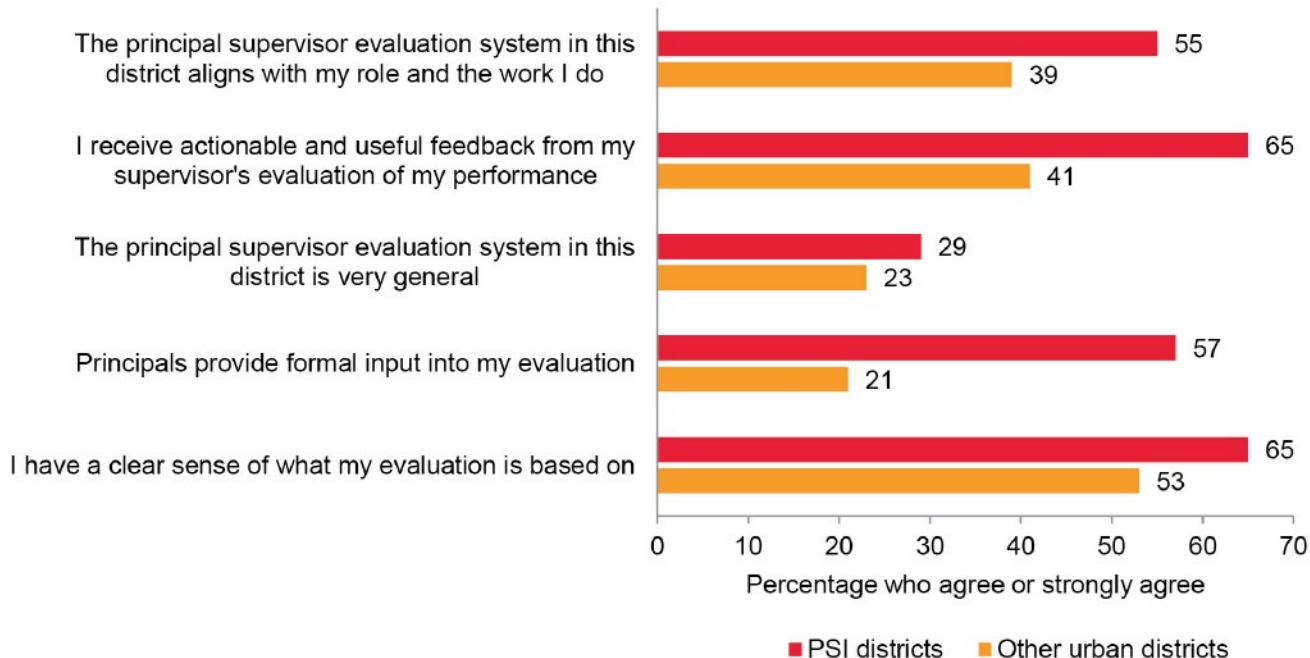

Note: The survey question read, “Based on your experiences in the current 2017–2018 school year, how strongly do you agree or disagree with the following statements about the principal supervisor evaluation system in this district?” Supervisors rated their agreement on a 5-point Likert-type scale. Differences between supervisors in PSI and other urban districts are statistically significant at the 5 percent level for “The principal supervisor evaluation system in this district aligns with my role and the work I do,” “I receive actionable and useful feedback from my supervisors’ evaluations of my performance,” and “Principals provide formal input into my evaluation.”
